## **▶** Overview:

Globalization, rapid technological changes and changing employees' values are all factors that caused constant upheavals in the 21<sup>st</sup> century. It is in this context that leaders must enact effective behavior in order to bring out the best in their followers and enhance organizational effectiveness. Organizational effectiveness is no longer driven alone by the availability of capital and machines. - Explain and critically evaluate different theories and approaches to leadership
- Apply these theories to a range of cases that exemplify the challenges and responsibilities leaders face in a variety of organizational contexts
- Develop and communicate a critical awareness of one's own leadership mindset
- Establish practices of learning, reflection and communication that will encourage and strengthen their own continual process of leadership development
- Critically evaluate leadership issues pertaining to ethics, probity and governance.
- Understand the key idea that leaders are to exhibit ethical behavior. It is not good enough to get the job done; leaders must get the job done using ethical methods.
